On March 23, 2024, the exhibition "Mind the Memory Gap" by the artist Franz Wanner will open at Kindl – Zentrum für Zeitgenössische Kunst. In his first solo exhibition in Berlin (24.3. – 14.7.2024), Franz Wanner investigates present-day repercussions of the widespread exploitation through forced labor under National Socialism. Using photographs, texts, films and objects, the artist reveals social continuities from the Nazi era to today as well as gaps in Germany's culture of remembrance. Wanner was a residency fellow of the Harun Farocki Residency in collaboration with Farocki Forum and Kindl. More information here.

On April 8, 7 p.m., at Cabaret Voltaire in Zürich, Farocki Forum organizes a reading from Harun Farocki's texts around the theater play SCHLACHT/TRAKTOR, which Farocki staged with Hanns Zischler at the Theater Basel in 1976.
